It has been established in honour of our community partner, How to Do Some Good, whose founder Mandy Pui, is also a board member of The Kindness Foundation.

How to Do Some Good is a collaborative and inclusive group of individuals giving back to the community in Vancouver and Victoria, Canada. One of the purposes of The Kindness Foundation is to support registered charities and community causes by developing and organizing volunteer events, and recruiting members of the public across any demographic to provide social good in the areas of; the environment, children and youth, families, the aged, those living with disabilities, or providing public amenities. The Kindness Foundation and How to Do Some Good work in alignment to organize these community events to connect and give back to the community and to promote kindness.

It is our hope that the recipient of this scholarship will be enabled to grow their personal commitment to service in their community, empowered to implement a service project, and continue their education to become a well-rounded, kind and contributing member of society.

Criteria for the Scholarship:

The intention of this fund is to recognize exceptional high school graduating students, inspired by the vision of a kinder world and committed to making a difference, with a scholarship to assist them in furthering their education.

It is our hope that the recognition of our recipient's important work will inspire them to continue to be involved in similar initiatives through their post-secondary years and into adult life.

Recipient Profile:

- You are inspired by the vision of a kinder world and have the character and commitment to undertake wholeheartedly a project that will create positive

impact in the community, locally or globally. (The Kindness Foundation and How to Do Some Good will provide some volunteers as well as financial support to a maximum of \$200.00 to support your project.)

- You have demonstrated your commitment and leadership to positive action, contribution, or raising awareness in past activities.
- You inspire others, not only through your actions, but by being who you are.
- You are compassionate, aware, open-minded, and innovative.
- You understand the value of education, recognizing that a well-rounded person embraces learning opportunities inside and outside of school.
- You personally strive for excellence at but maintain a healthy greater perspective in your pursuit of it that allows you to experience life and its joys.
- You may be someone whose access to post-secondary education would be significantly improved by receiving the financial assistance that this scholarship provides. This is not necessary but will be taken into consideration.

The Scholarship Award:

Scholarship: The recipient will receive a scholarship of \$1000.00 to assist in their post-secondary education.

Application Process and Deadlines:

Applications should be post marked on or before **April 16, 2020**.

Applications should include a Personal Statement, information about past and current involvement in 'Kindness Initiatives' and a community project proposal. See more information in the application.

The applicant should emphasize his/her leadership role, specific contributions, and results and successes directly based on the applicant's actions. If these were group initiatives, please outline your specific responsibilities and contributions to the project. Include information about the success of the projects as part of the submissions. Please include information about your motivation, challenges that you may have encountered, and the impact that you are making or hope to make.
